Will Council please explain and communicate to the public the difference between "affordable" housing, "attainable" housing and "social" housing? At the current time there appears to be a significant divergence of common understanding very similar to the historical debate about whether a tomato is a fruit or a vegetable.

Who is the Gateway Project actually meant to house? Snippets of information seem to indicate trades and professionals that are normally part of the development industry, doctors, nurses and teachers or will the Gateway Project also be affordable for those who work within the recreation and leisure industry without prejudice to those with less financial resources? Will the Project house a certain percentage of people who live with disabilities or who are retired?

If the Gateway Project enjoys the luxury of being subsidized by the taxpayer in any way, should the public not have a say on who the Gateway Project is actually for? Should the voice of the public not be heard on the overall nature of the project if in the end it effects our planning process and the overall vision of the community?
